GLACIER BAY CRUISE

DAY 1 JUNEAU, EMBARKATION

Your cruise departs today from Juneau, a charming small town first settled during the gold rush of the 1880's. Toast your voyage as the Wilderness Discoverer departs towards Icy Strait. D

DAY 2 ICY STRAIT & NEKA BAY

Begin your morning with on-deck yoga stretches. There are options aplenty today. Glide around the remote bays of Icy Strait by kayak, through giant bullwhip kelp that can grow to over 100 feet long. Alternatively hop aboard a skiff to explore a rocky outcropping or pull on some mud boots for a forest hike with your naturalist guides who have plenty to share about everything Alaska. B L D

DAYS 3/4 GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK

Over the next two days, discover the wonders of the UNESCO World Heritage Listed Glacier Bay National Park - the jewel in Alaska's crown. Cruise into Taylor Bay and witness sea stacks and rocky shores. You might also have the chance to hike into the Fairweather Mountain Range. In nearby Dundas Bay you may be able to go kayaking or bushwalking, and wildlife sightings could include bears, humpbacks or even wolves. On Day 6, explore South Marble Island – a birder's paradise home to Puffins, Guillemots and Gulls. Cruise to the far end of Tidal Inlet to see impressive Margerie and Grand Pacific glaciers. Backed by knife-edged peaks, it's also possible to see bears forage along the shoreline of Tidal Inlet. B L D

DAY 5 CHICHAGOF ISLAND

Today, meander through glacier-carved fjords along the Chichagof coast. It's a prime time to lower the kayaks or explore the coastline. With one of the world's largest populations of bears, it's possible to see them today. Go searching for giant trees and tidal pools. B L D

DAY 6 FREDERICK SOUND

Enjoy the show today. You may find yourself surrounded by feeding humpbacks that travel through and feed in these abundant glacial waters. Based on wind and weather, your expedition team has the lineup of adventures all mapped out. Cruise past Five Fingers Lighthouse, Alaska's oldest light station and The Brothers Islands, where sea lions nap on rocky outcrops. You might want to grab a kayak and paddle into Port Houghton or Windham Bay, or head ashore for a hike. Tonight, toast another big day in Alaska. B L D

DAY 7 TRACY ARM

Wake up this morning amidst beautiful fjords. Cruise through Tracy Arm, keeping an eye out for harbor seals and their pups. The cotton candy blue Twin Sawyer glaciers are the highlight today. Tides permitting, explore by skiff as your guide points out wildlife and geological wonders – towering walls and plenty of waterfalls. B L D

DAY 8 JUNEAU, TOUR ENDS

Enjoy a final breakfast onboard this morning, before saying goodbye to your crew and newfound friends. Transfer to Juneau airport or hotel. Tour ends. B
