PUNO TO LA PAZ

2 days/1 night

INCLUSIONS

Road transfer from hotel in Puno to Copacabana and from La Chua to La Paz, 1 night catamaran crossing in lake view cabin with private facilities, meals and sightseeing as per itinerary.

Explore mysterious Lake Titicaca (3,812m), sacred to the Incas, and according to Incan mythology, the birthplace of the first Inca King, Manco Capac. Discover its history and scenic beauty as you sail across the waters, visiting indigenous villages and Sun Island, where the Sun God was born.

Day 1 Lake Titicaca

Transfer by road to Copacabana and cruise to Sun Island. Visit the Inti Wata Cultural Complex, which includes a unique sailing experience on a huge Titikaka traditional reed vessel and the Pilkokaina Inca Palace. Dinner and overnight on board. LD.

Day 2 Tour ends La Paz

Enter a smaller section of the lake known as Winay Marca, where you tour the communities of Pariti, Kalauta and Patapatani. Inspect fine Tiwanaku ceramics, row amongst totorales (reeds) and explore a sprawling necropolis. Tour ends. BL

Airfare La Paz to Uyuni (subject to change), 4 nights accommodation, meals and transfers as per itinerary, services of an English speaking guide and entrance fees.

Visit Bolivia's central highlands and the surreal landscapes of Salar de Uyuni, the world's largest salt lake, stretching for hundreds of kilometres. Explore the picturesque city of Potosi, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its cobblestone streets and baroque colonial architecture.

Day 1 Uyuni/Ojo de Perdiz

Fly La Paz to Uyuni. On arrival, you are met and transferred to Ojo de Perdiz, via the train cemetery, the villages of Alota and Kulpina K, the mining town of San Cristobal and the Valley of Rocks. Overnight Hotel Tayka del Desierto. L

Day 2 Ojo de Perdiz

Depart for the Eduardo Avaroa Andean Fauna National Reserve, crossing the Siloli Desert to the Red Lagoon, home to abundant flamingo. View the impressive Green Lagoon beneath the Licancabur Volcano. Overnight Hotel Tayka del Desierto. BL

Day 3 Uyuni Salt Flat/Colchani

Visit the iconic Uyuni Salt Flats, stopping at the Galaxy Caves and Incahuasi Island, with its giant cacti. In the wet season (Nov-Mar), the itinerary may vary. Overnight at Luna Salada. BL

Day 4 Potosi

Leave for Potosi, one of the highest cities in the world, and famous for its baroque churches, monuments and grand colonial architecture. Overnight at Hostal Colonial. B

Day 5 Tour ends Sucre

Transfer from Potosi to Sucre. Tour ends. B
